

ORDINANCE NO 10306 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO ADMINISTRATIVE
CODE ARTICLE III, SECTION 81 RELATING TO CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:


Section 1: Section 81 of Article III of the County of San Diego Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 81. CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

Except as authorized by the County Charter, no person shall be certified to the hereinafter specified positions in the classified Civil Service or employed or appointed to the hereinafter specified positions or offices in the unclassified service, unless such person is a native-born or fully naturalized citizen of the United States or an alien lawfully permitted to work in the United States. This provision applies to the following County officers and employees: Members of the Assessment Appeals Board, Members of the Civil Service Commission, Members of the Planning Commission, Members of the Noise Control Hearing Board, Chief Deputy County Assessor, Chief Deputy County Clerk, Chief Deputy County Recorder, Assistant District Attorney, Chief Deputy District Attorney, Undersheriff, Assistant Sheriff, Chief Deputy, Chief Deputy County Tax Collector, Chief Deputy County Treasurer, all members of Executive Management specified in the Compensation Ordinance of the County of San Diego, County Counsel, Assistant County Counsel, Hearing Officer-Appeals appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and all Commanders, Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants and Deputy Sheriffs in the Sheriff's Department and all peace officers, as defined in Chapter 4.5 (commencing with Section 830) of Title 3 of Part 2 of the Penal Code.

Section 2: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. Within fifteen days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the name of those members voting for and against the same in the newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.


