Types of work performed by GENERAL VOLUNTEERS in this category:

Edgemoor continues to assist local schools in providing training for nursing student interns from Brightwood, Concorde, National and Grossmont Community College. Additionally, students from Christian college (Santee) offer volunteer services several times a year and carolers visit at holiday time to sing songs for the residents. We also have volunteers who work in the dietary department. Community volunteers at Edgemoor include religious affiliates from local churches who volunteer several times a month, animal handlers with pet therapy dogs from the Helen Woodward animal shelter and local individuals who bring their own pets several times a week for the residents to interact with. The Kiwanis Club provides a pancake breakfast four times a year for the residents to enjoy. And, Edgemoor holds a volunteer-run car show twice a year.

These are our regular volunteers who provide socialization to residents by assisting and providing support to departments as needed for duties not assigned to staff. These volunteers lend a hand at arts and craft classes, visit with the residents on a one/on/one ratio and read books, newspapers and magazines through a reading group. Additionally, they sit with the residents by providing a listening ear, offer friendship to Edgemoor residents confined to the hospital and offer conversation and respite to residents who live here. These volunteers also assist in the logistics of getting Edgemoor residents to their designated onsite activities including music/sing alone groups, drum circles, etc...
