Volunteers assisted with user acceptance testing for ELR (electronic laboratory reports), and were instrumental in troubleshooting and identifying issues needing to be addressed in order for the laboratories to directly transmit reports electronically. The intern from SDSU also helped with monthly STD reports as well as other regularly scheduled quarterly, annual reports. Volunteer assisted with developing draft policies related to improving HIV care and treatment in clinic settings.

The UCSD volunteer activities have included development of policies and procedures, intake forms, and patient instructional materials for the program as well as chart reviews and data abstraction. More recent activities have been data analysis and preparation of an abstract that will be presented at an upcoming conference.

8. VOLUNTEER PROGRAM GOALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-18:

The goals for HSHB interns is to help with the large workload while also training someone for future employment with the County. This includes: learning about data entry and analysis for the three primary sexually transmitted diseases in San Diego County, evaluation, research and analysis, learning about aspects of health administration and policy development related to HIV care and treatment in San Diego County.

The goals for the UCSD volunteers is to 1) develop and implement express visits in the STD clinics 2) develop policies, procedures, intake forms, patient instructions, and other written materials necessary for the program. 3) compare rates of response in RPR titer following treatment for early syphilis 4) determine frequency and clinical characteristics of patients who fail to serorevert to a nonreactive RPR following appropriate syphilis treatment, and assess outcomes over time in those patients.

The internship is flexible and there are always opportunities to develop students to understand public health work.
