The Senior Volunteer Patrol, Explorers, and Mounted Volunteer Units participated in numerous parades and charitable events. Additionally, they continue to represent the department at the Teddy Bear Drive, Shop with a Cop, National Night Out and our Holiday watch programs. General volunteers have continued to supplement patrol during DUI checkpoints, large scale events (such as the Avocado Festival in Fallbrook, Sand Castles in Imperial Beach), county wide events (which include Christmas parades, rodeos, car shows, sporting events, etc.), incident scenes, officer involved shootings, and overall general patrol. Volunteers respond 24/7 to assist Sheriff's personnel with whatever is needed. The Dive Unit participated in four search missions: a mutual aid response, two body recovery missions, and assisted Oceanside Police Department with a gun recovery in the ocean.
