A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTYWIDE REDEVELOPMENT
SUCCESSOR AGENCY OVERSIGHT BOARD APPROVING THE
DISSOLUTION OF THE OCEANSIDE SUCCESSION AGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oceanside created the Oceanside
Redevelopment Agency (the "Agency") by adoption of Ordinance No. 73-60 on November 1,
1973; and

WHEREAS, the California Legislature dissolved all redevelopment agencies in 2012 and
created successor agencies by adoption of the Redevelopment Dissolution Law (Health and
Safety Code Section 34170 et seq.) (the "Dissolution Law"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Dissolution Law, the Oceanside City Council adopted
Resolution No. 12-R0058-1 on January 10, 2012, electing to serve as the Successor Agency to
the Agency (the "Successor Agency"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34187(b) of the Dissolution Law, when all of the
Successor Agency's enforceable obligations have been repaid, all real property has been
disposed of, and all outstanding litigation has been resolved, the successor agency shall submit to
the oversight board a request, with a copy of the request to the county auditor-controller, to
formally dissolve the Successor Agency; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2026, the Oceanside City Council adopted Resolution No. 26-
R0373-1 to request that the San Diego County Oversight Board approve the dissolution of the
Successor Agency and submit the City Council's request to the California Department of
Finance in accordance with Health and Safety Code Section 34187(b); and

WHEREAS, the City Council's request to formally dissolve the Successor Agency was
sent to the Countywide Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board of San Diego
County, with a copy to the San Diego County Auditor-Controller, on July 20, 2026.

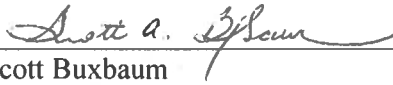
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NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTYWIDE OVERSIGHT BOARD OF SAN DIEGO
COUNTY DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. All of the recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein.
2. The City Council's request to dissolve the Successor Agency is hereby approved.
3. The San Diego County Oversight Board is directed to submit the Oceanside City Council's request to the California Department of Finance in accordance with Health and Safety Code Section 34187(b).
4. This Resolution is effective on the date of its adoption.
