

If you are or will be financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic,



you may be eligible for the following benefits:

If you are unable to work because:



You are sick or quarantined
due to exposure to COVID-19
(certified by a medical professional)

File a Disability Insurance (DI) claim

- get short-term benefit payments
- 60-70% of your wages
- \$50 - \$1,300 a week



You are caregiving for an ill or
quarantined family member with COVID-
19 (certified by a medical professional)

File a Paid Family Leave (PFL) claim

- get up to six weeks of benefit payments
- 60-70% of your wages
- \$50 - \$1,300 a week



Your child's school is closed,
do not have other childcare options,
and unable to work remotely

File an Unemployment Insurance claim

- EDD will decide if you are eligible



**Your job closed down or
work hours are reduced**

File an Unemployment Insurance (UI) claim

- get partial wage replacement
- Must remain ready to work each week of claim
- \$40-\$450 per week.

If self-employed:

Visit Self-Employed/Independent Contractor to learn more.

- Available benefits are insurance programs.
- To be eligible, contributions must be made in the past 5 to 18 months.
- Apply for the benefit program most appropriate for your situation.
