 - Facilities that store or handle hazardous materials at or above 55 gallons of a liquid, 500 pounds of a solid, and/or 200 cubic feet of a non-inert gas.
 - Not including medical gases (oxygen, nitrous oxide, nitrogen) which have higher reporting thresholds at or above 1,000 cubic feet.
