



UST Compatibility with Hazardous Substance for New Installations
Title 23, California Code of Regulations, Section 2631 (I), 2712b)(5)



For all USTs installed on or after October 1, 2018, the UST owner or operator must demonstrate compatibility at the time of installation for all components of the UST system that may come into contact with the substance stored. The additional components for which compatibility must be demonstrated include, but are not limited to, spill containers, overfill prevention equipment, and ancillary equipment. **Documents demonstrating compatibility must be provided as part of the application for a UST operating permit and must be retained by the UST owner or operator for as long as the UST stores that specific substance.**
