Complete and submit this page after cleaning any underground or aboveground tank system subject to Title 22, Division 4.5, Chapter 32, California Code of Regulations. Refer to 22 CCR 67383.3 and 23 CCR 2672 for disposal requirements for tank systems.

To certify that the tank system is meeting the standards in 22 CCR 67383.3 (e)(1), (e)(2), and (g), complete and submit this Hazardous Waste Tank Closure Certification (or an alternative version or a computer-generated facsimile) for each tank system that meets all of the following\*:

- the tank system held a hazardous material or a hazardous waste and the tank system is identified as a hazardous waste.
- the tank system is destined to be disposed, reclaimed, or closed in place.

\* This does not apply to tank systems regulated under a hazardous waste facility permit, other than permit by rule (PBR), or to tank systems regulated under a grant of interim status, nor to a tank system or any portion thereof, that meets the definition of scrap metal in 22 CCR Section 66260.10 and is excluded from regulation pursuant to 22 CCR Section 66261.6(a)(3)(B).

**NOTE:** the submittal of this certification must include the Business Activities and the Business Owner/Operator pages found in your CERS account. It is preferred this certification be submitted through the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS) by marking YES to the Business Activities question regarding HW Tank Closure and submitting the form in the Hazardous Waste Tank Closure Certification CERS element. If unable to submit electronically, you may email this Hazardous Waste Tank Closure Certification to your area inspector or HMD Duty Desk ([DEH.HMDUTYEH@sdcounty.ca.gov](mailto:DEH.HMDUTYEH@sdcounty.ca.gov)) along with a copy of the Business Activities and the Business Owner/Operator pages.

Refer to 22 CCR Section 67383.3 and 23 CCR Section 2672 for disposal requirements for tank systems.

Copies of the certificate shall be provided to the following:

- CUPA, authorized agency or LIA;
- owner and/or operator of the tank system;
- the contractor responsible for the removal of the tank system; and
- the recycling or disposal facility to which the tank is transported.

A copy of the certificate shall accompany the tank to the recycling/disposal facility.

**Data Field Instructions:** hover over the fields on the form to view the field numbers

1. Facility ID Number - Enter the 6-character Permit # on your Unified Program Facility Permit (UPFP). If you do not have a UPFP, leave this blank.

3. BUSINESS NAME - Enter the full legal name of the business. This is the same as the terms "Facility Name" or "DBA".

746. CONCENTRATION OF FLAMMABLE VAPOR 1-3: For each tank, enter interior flammable vapor levels taken at the top, center, and bottom of the tank. (Enter additional tank numbers in 749 and 752.)

747. CONCENTRATION OF OXYGEN 1-3: For each tank, enter oxygen levels taken at the top, center, and bottom of the tank. (Enter additional tank numbers in 750 and 753.)

754. CERTIFIER NAME: Enter the full printed name of the person signing the page

755. CERTIFIER TITLE: Enter the title of the person signing the page.

756. CERTIFIER ADDRESS: Enter the address of the person signing the page.

757. CERTIFIER CITY/STATE: Enter the city and state for the signer's address.

758. CERTIFIER PHONE: Enter the phone number for the person signing the page.

759. DATE CERTIFIED: Enter the date that the document was signed. Enter the time that the readings were taken.

760. CERTIFIER REPRESENTS LOCAL AGENCY: Check "Yes" if the person certifying the tank is a representative of the CUPA, authorized agency, or LIA; check "No" if not.

761. NAME OF LOCAL AGENCY: Enter the name of the local agency represented by the person certifying the tank.

762. AFFILIATION OF CERTIFYING PERSON: Check the certification, license, or organization which the certifier holds or to which the certifying person belongs, if not a CUPA/LIA.

763. TANK HELD FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS: Check "Yes" if the tank held flammable or combustible materials; check "No" if not.

764. MANAGEMENT INSTRUCTIONS: Provide tank management instructions to the scrap dealer, disposal facility, etc., in this space.
