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In accordance with Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27CCR) §21660.3, please be advised that the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has received and accepted an application from EDCO Waste & Recycling Services for a Medium Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert Debris Processing Facility Registration Permit. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego, excluding the City of San Diego.

This project is an existing Medium Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert Debris Processing Facility. The operator's proposed updates to the Facility Plan require the operator to submit a new Solid Waste Facility Registration Permit application package for LEA review and processing. The Facility Plan updates include the name of the landowner, equipment addition, and approval of the fire control plan by the San Marcos Fire Department. The operational area, tonnages, hours of operation, and traffic will remain the same. The types of materials permitted under this new application do not differ from those already handled at this facility.

LEA Determination: The operation is defined and authorized by California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Division 7, Chapter 3, Article 5.9. Because a Registration Permit cannot be modified or revised, a new Registration Permit is required. The issuance of the new permit is a ministerial action by the LEA. A Notice of Exemption will be filed with the San Diego County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse.

A copy of the permit application is available for review by appointment at the Department of Environmental Health office located at 5500 Overland Drive, Suite 110, San Diego.
