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The County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has accepted an application package for a modification to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Universal Refuse Removal Recycling and Transfer Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego, excluding the City of San Diego.

Description of Proposed Permit Modification: The proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit modification contains non-material changes to reflect updates to the legal description of the facility to reference Assessor Parcel Numbers: 482-131-16-00 and 482-131-02-00; to update LEA findings and references to current operating permits; and to amend the Transfer/Processing Report to describe current operations.

LEA Findings: The LEA has reviewed and considered the information, including the environmental effects of modifying this Solid Waste Facility Permit. No substantive changes are proposed in the project and there are no substantive changes in the circumstances under which the project will be undertaken. The LEA finds that there are no significant environmental effects arising out of the issuance of this modified Solid Waste Facility Permit. A Notice of Exemption will be filed with the San Diego County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse.
