The County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health and Quality, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and has accepted for filing an application package for an amendment to the Report of Facility Information (RFI) otherwise known as the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for SANCO Resource Recovery. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego excluding the City of San Diego.

Description of Proposed RFI Amendment: The operator has submitted an RFI Amendment application which includes an update to the transfer station Transfer Processing Report (TPR) to reflect the correct daily design and tonnage capacity and updated maps, facility site plan and equipment layout. The operational area, tonnages, hours of operation, and traffic will remain the same. The types of materials permitted under this new application do not differ from those already handled at this facility.

LEA Findings: The LEA has determined pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 21665(c), the RFI amendment is consistent with the adopted Negative Declaration dated

July 2005. A Notice of Exemption will be filed with the County Clerk by the LEA stating that the amendments to the TPR are categorically exempt under CEQA guidelines. The RFI amendments are acceptable and consistent with, but not limited to, state minimum standards; and the amendments do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facility permit.
