The County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and has accepted for filing an application package for a revision to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for Escondido Resource Recovery (ERR). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego excluding the City of San Diego.

Description of Proposed Permit Revision: The operator submitted an application package for the construction of two of four Anaerobic Digesters (AD) within the ERR facility complex. The construction of two AD had been previously approved by the LEA on June 7, 2017 as Phase 4 of the EDI Master Plan. The construction will require the operator to update the ERR Report of Facility Information and develop an In-Vessel Digester Report and Odor Impact Minimization Plan as part of the SWFP revision. A total of 650 tons per day will be received for anaerobic digesters. The revision will not result in change to maximum daily tonnage, hours of operation or permitted acres of the facility.

LEA Findings per §21665(e): The County of San Diego, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency finds the proposed changes are consistent with California Environmental Quality Act documents; and pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations §21665, that the proposed changes in site operations requires a revised SWFP. A Notice of Determination will be filed.
