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The County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health and Quality Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has accepted an application package for a modification to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Palomar Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of San Diego excluding the City of San Diego.

Description of Proposed Permit Modification: The proposed modified Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) contains nonmaterial changes to reflect updates to the legal description of the facility to reference Assessor Parcel Number 760-166-84-00, LEA findings, and references to other regulatory permits. Changes to the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR) include updates to the introduction section, references to a limited volume transfer operation on the property, adjacent

land uses, a description of the mattress recycling program and storage area, typographical corrections in the design capacity and peak loading calculations, inclusion of equipment capacities, average daily tonnage of waste to 2019 current data, and updates to methods to comply with the following state minimum standards: Salvaged Material, Litter Control, Nuisance Control, Supervision and Personnel, Visual Screening, and Traffic Control. References to current permits and appendices are also included. The modification of the solid waste facility permit does not change the permitted daily tonnage, traffic volume, hours of operation, or types of wastes received.

LEA Findings: The LEA has reviewed and considered the information, including the environmental effects of modifying this Solid Waste Facility Permit. The LEA's preliminary determination pursuant to Title 27 California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), §21665 is that no substantive changes are proposed in the project and there are no substantive changes in the circumstances under which the project will be undertaken and finds that there are no significant environmental effects arising out of the issuance of this modified Solid Waste Facility Permit. A Notice of Exemption will be filed with the San Diego County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse.
