



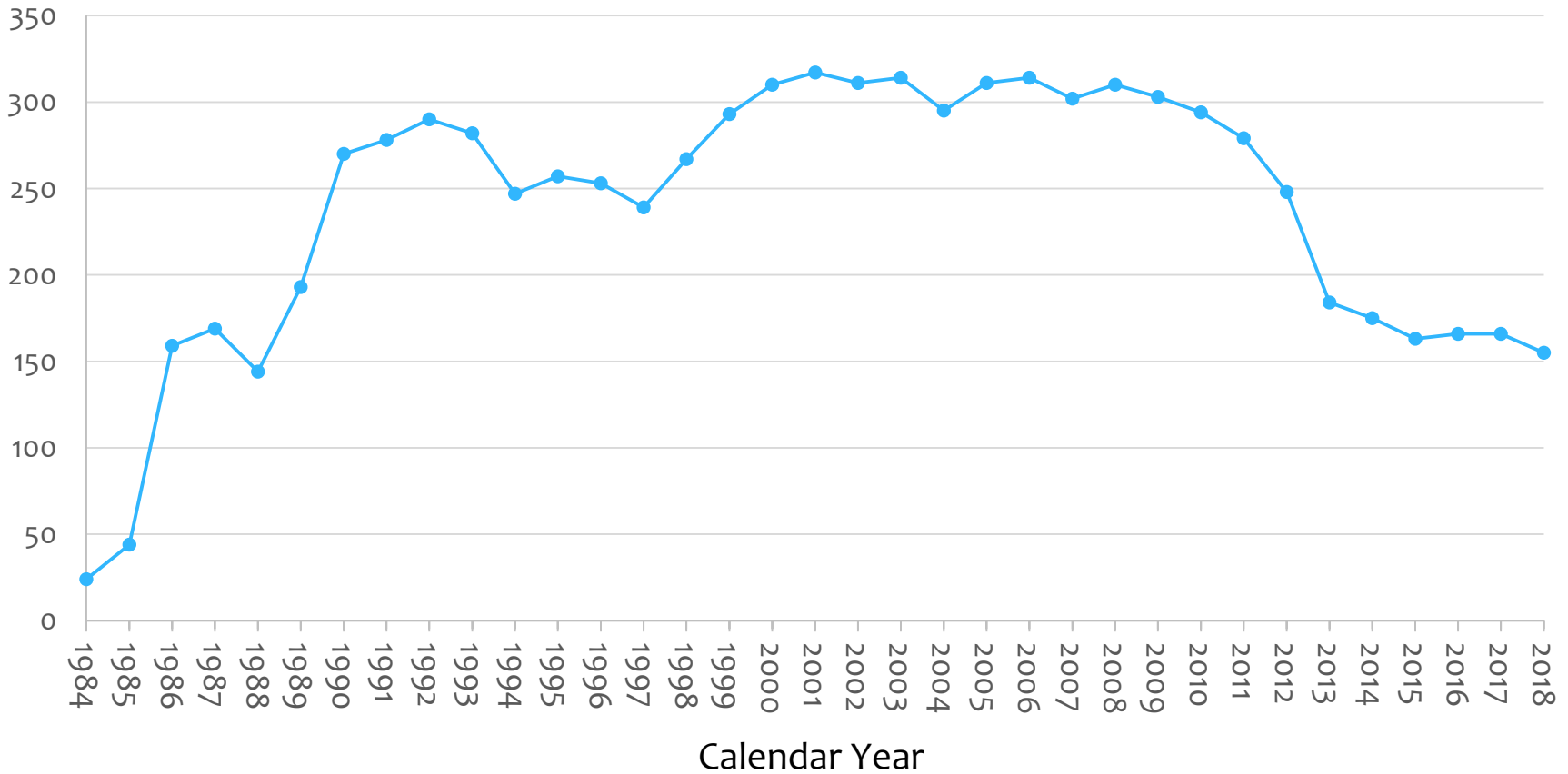

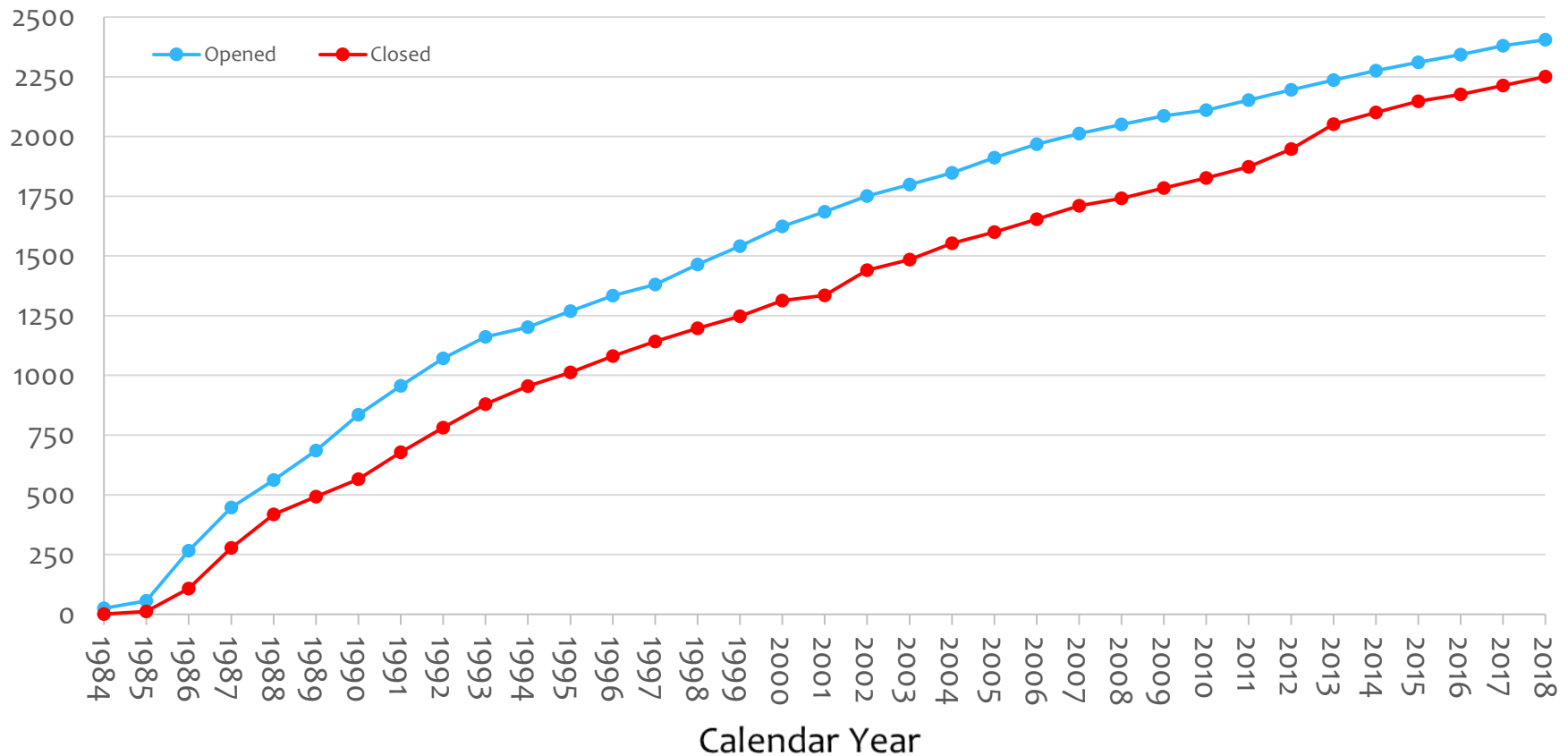

## October 20, 2018



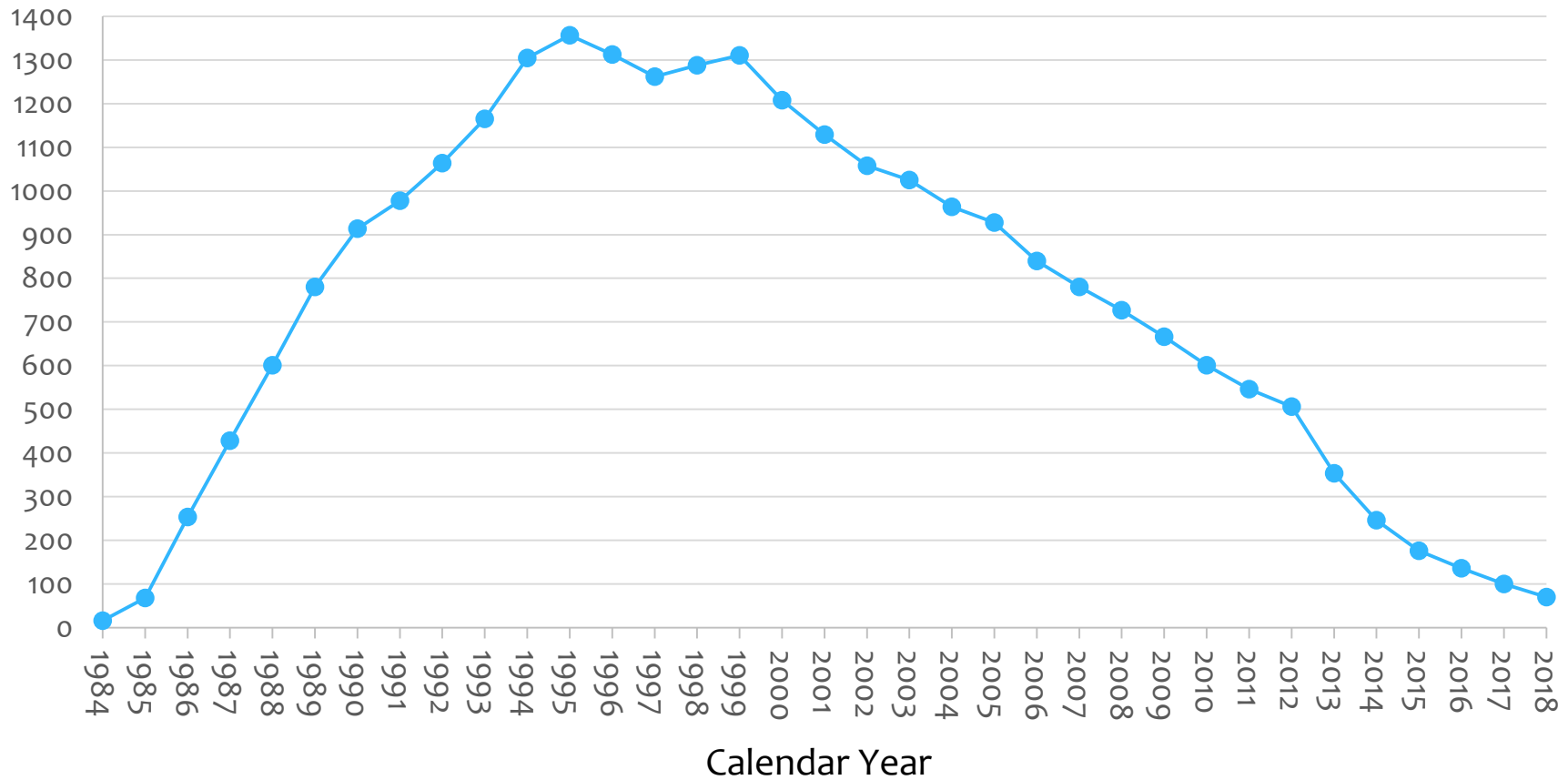

# Potential Mercury Spill

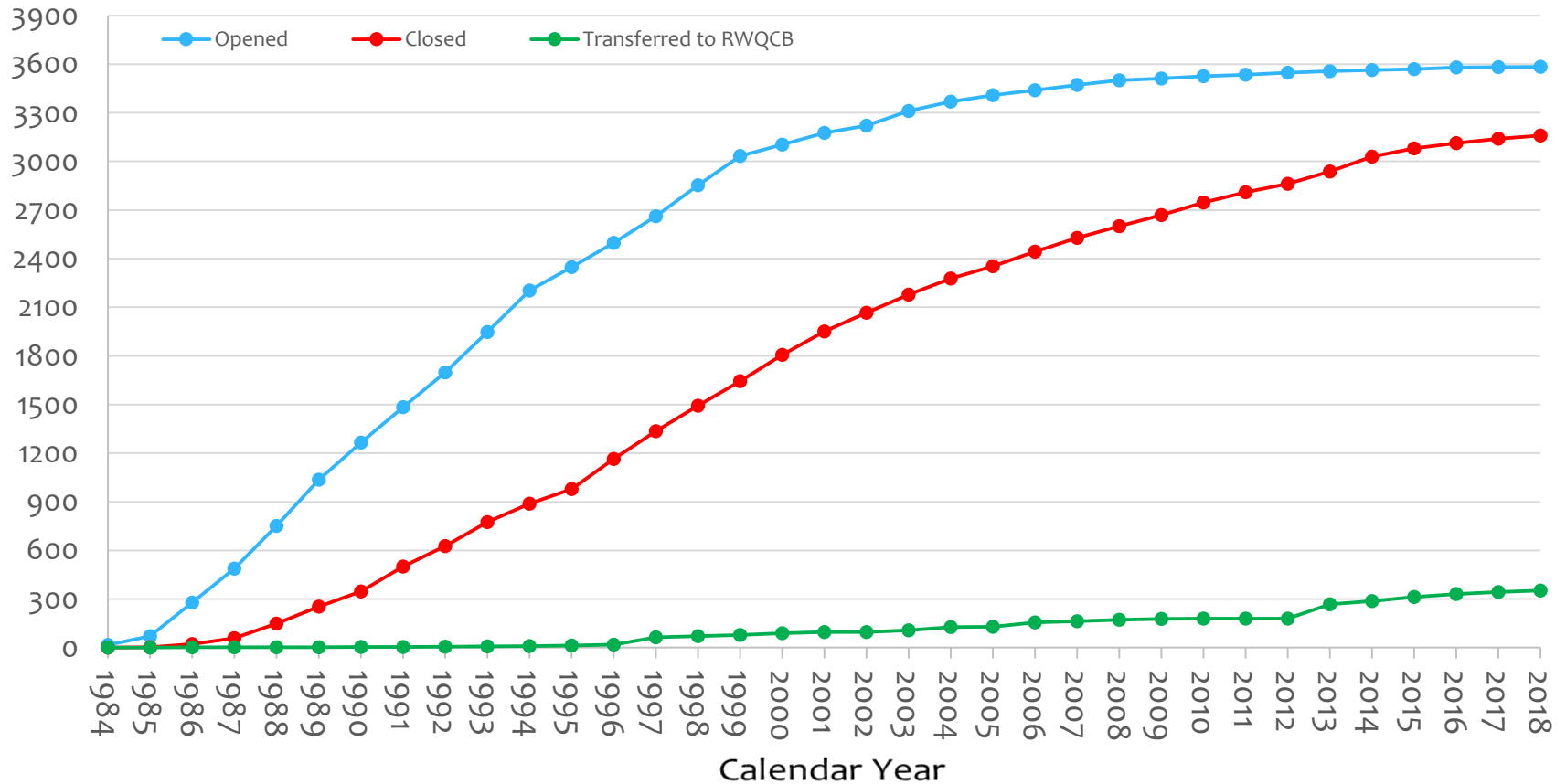

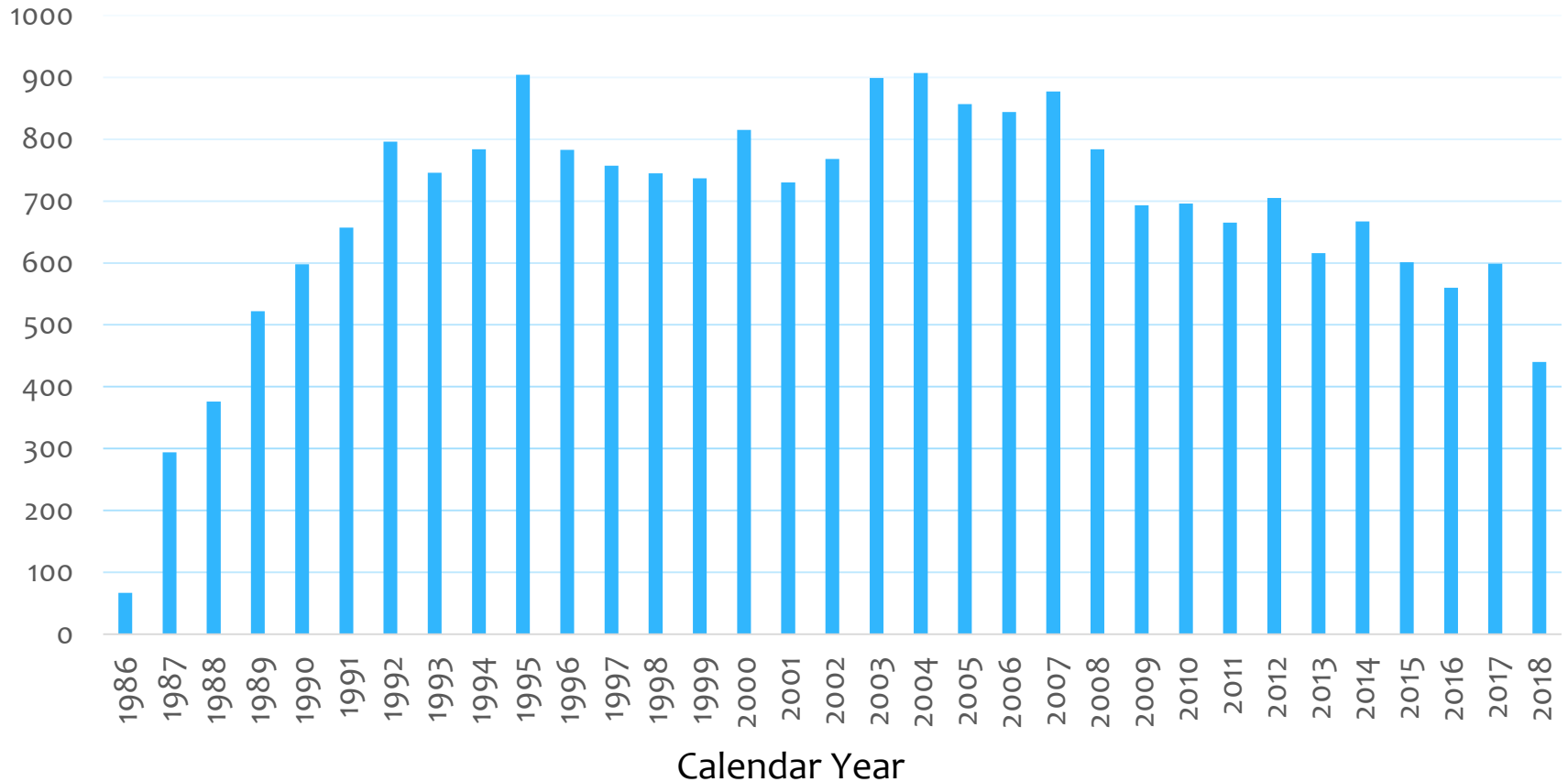
