Be sure to eat from vendors/facilities that have been inspected by the Department of Environmental Health to ensure they have proper food safety training, use approved equipment, and are inspected for safe food handling and proper sanitation.

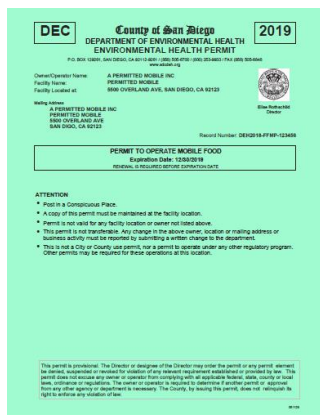


Don't eat food from vendors or facilities that are missing a health permit, food grade card, or decal.



When deciding what you want to eat, make sure the food vendor or facility is approved by the County Department of Environmental Health by looking for any of the following:

Health Permit



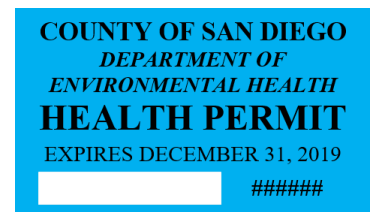
Food Facility Grade Card
