UPDATE TO THE GFDC CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

BACKGROUND

The Political Reform Act (Government Code § 87200, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code.

Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statements of economic interests with the GFDC, which will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction (Gov. Code § 81008). All statements will be retained by the GFDC.

OR

All officials set forth in Government Code § 87200 and designated positions shall file their Statement of Economic Interest, also known as the Form 700, with the GFDC via the e-file web portal managed by the County of San Diego. Digital copies of such statements are maintained by the Clerk of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors. The Clerk of the Board will make all digital statements and electronic filings available for public inspection and reproduction during regular business hours (Gov. Code § 81008.)

The current Gillespie Field Development Council's Conflict of Interest Code does not state who will manage the statements.

Motion

The Gillespie Field Development Council recommends that the Conflict of Interest Statements be filed via the e-file web portal managed by the County of San Diego. Digital copies of such statements are maintained by the Clerk of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors. The Clerk of the Board will make all digital statements and electronic filings available for public inspection and reproduction during regular business hours (Gov. Code § 81008.)
