ANNUAL COMMITTEE REPORT ON PALOMAR AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE ACTIVITIES FOR 2018

This report was prepared in accordance with Article XL, § 738 of the Administrative Code of the County of San Diego. This report covers activities for the calendar year 2018, which included eight PAAC meetings.

Findings and Recommendations

January 18, 2018

- Chairman Chuck Collins and Vice Chairman Cliff Kaiser were re-elected to their positions.

February 15, 2018

- Ms. Carmichael and Ms. Curtis conducted a power point presentation overview of the forecast, design, alternatives and the Program EIR for the Master Plan. The proposed motion to submit a letter in support of the milestones made and to support the extension of the public comment period was approved.

April 19, 2018

- Mr. Hodgson, Senior Real Property Agent, presented information regarding a proposed amendment with Western Flight, Inc. The amendment would provide a five-year rental adjustment and update lease language. The effective date for this amendment would be August 16, 2018. The recommended motion to provide a five-year rental adjustment and update lease language was approved.

May 17, 2018

- No motion items presented.

June 21, 2018

- Ms. Baldwin, Project Manager, presented information regarding proposed action regarding declaring the Loker Avenue Property surplus land. The recommended motion for Board of Supervisors to declare Loker Avenue property surplus land was approved.
- Ms. Baldwin, Project Manager, presented information regarding a proposed amendment to a lease with Palomar Airport Center LLC D.B.A Atlantic Aviation-CRQ. The recommended motion to amend and to negotiate market rent was approved.
- Chairman Collins presented options for PAAC member bio's on the County of San Diego PAAC website. The recommended motion to have a web presence was approved.

August 16, 2018

- No motion items presented.

September 20, 2018

- Mr. Griffiths and Ms. Curtis presented information regarding the Master Plan Update. The proposed motion to recommend to the Board of Supervisors to vote on B-II enhanced alternatives and, in the future, consider the D-III modification was approved.

November 15, 2018

- A draft of the PAAC Annual Report for 2018 was presented to the committee for review and recommendations. The committee carried a motion that the Chairman sign the Annual Report for 2018 as drafter at the meeting.

Additional Activities

The PAAC meetings serve as a public forum for residents to express comment and ask questions about airport operations. Much of the public comment is in regard to aircraft noise concerns. Public comment allows for the PAAC and Airport staff to inform residents about airport operations and explore the opportunities to address their concerns.

The PAAC also supports the Fly Friendly program in several ways. A significant component of that program is education. The PAAC has taken a role of educating residents in the local communities, as well as the pilot communities. At each meeting, a Fly Friendly update is provided and the offer is extended to interested Home Owners' Associations and community groups for informational airport presentations. PAAC members regularly accompany Airport staff to provide those presentations. The PAAC also works closely with airport users and pilot communities, including the Palomar Airport Association. PAAC members and Airport staff frequently attend the Palomar Airport Association meetings to provide airport updates and information regarding the Fly Friendly program.

Informative presentations were provided to committee members and residents at several of the PAAC meetings in 2018. In January, Mr. Alex provided an update on the Master Plan Update and the Program Environmental Impact Report. In June, Bruel & Kjaer provided an information presentation regarding Flight Tracking and Community Engagement.

The Palomar Airport Advisory Committee is proud to have served the County Board of Supervisors and the residents of North County in 2018.
