Mr. Collins has over 35 years of experience in the Aviation industry. He began his career as a Captain/Combat Pilot serving in Vietnam flying NSA intelligence missions. In the early 1970s, Chuck began flying in and out of the Carlsbad Airport. In 1995, he moved to North County and in 1998, he move to Carlsbad. He lives today in one of the 154 homes that are within the 60 Community Noise Equivalent Level (CNEL) of the airport's noise foot print. In 2001, Mr. Collins was appointed by Supervisor Horn to the Palomar Airport Advisory Committee. In 2008 he was elected as Chairmen.

Over the course of his career he has been Chief Pilot for multiple aviation companies and held various sales management positions that included responsibilities for three of the five major airframe manufactures. He was also Vice President of Sales for Jet East in Dallas, Texas.
