During the meeting, the Palomar Airport Advisory Committee (PAAC) and the Airport Project Team will...

- Discuss the potential options for the McClellan-Palomar Airport Master Plan; and
- Make a recommendation to the San Diego County Board of Supervisors for the selection of a preliminary preferred option.

Opportunities for Public Comment

The PAAC and Airport Project Team welcome public input. During the PAAC Committee meeting, attendees will have the opportunity to fill out speaker slips and provide public testimony.

What's Next?

Following the PAAC Committee meeting, the Board of Supervisors will review the PAAC's recommendation and provide direction to the Airport Project Team by selecting a preliminary preferred option, subject to the completion of an environmental review.

Once the preliminary preferred option is chosen by the Board of Supervisors, the Airport Project Team will complete the draft Airport Master Plan and present it at the fourth public workshop, which is scheduled for early 2016. Following the final public workshop, the Airport Project Team will begin drafting the Program-level Environmental Impact Report (PEIR). The Airport Project Team will be accepting written comments during the environmental review period. Once complete, the Board of Supervisors will be asked to certify the PEIR and approve the Master Plan.
