# How Can My Jurisdiction Use Aggregate Sustainability Reports?

- ▶ Budget considerations for future public works projects
- ▶ Long range planning (ie General Plan)
- ▶ Project Specific CEQA Review



# General Plan Implications

- ▶ County of San Diego General Plan Conservation Element
  - ▶ Strives to maintain availability of identified mineral resources
  - ▶ Ties to Mobility Element and Housing Element

# Discretionary Project Review

- ▶ Project Specific CEQA analysis for discretionary projects
  - ▶ Impacts to existing or future resources analyzed as part of a new project
  - ▶ Mitigation for Impacts at a Project Level, not regional level




# Potential Future Uses of Aggregate Mapping

- ▶ County General Plan envisions regional level program
  - ▶ Mining Overlay or Compatibility Designator
  - ▶ Identification of Mineral Resources
  - ▶ Mitigation Program
