



Quarry Road Low Water Crossing

Existing Need

Quarry Road east of the State Route 125 in Spring Valley has a low point in the road where it crosses over the Spring Valley creek, as shown below. Every year, the road closes several times due to flooding and residents are required to detour around the closure. Dry weather flows in the creek pass under the road through culverts, but during a moderate-to heavy rain event the creek flows over the roadway. Road closure gates were installed in the early 2000's, but they are not failsafe, and malfunction occasionally due to vandalism and mechanical failure. Traffic detours and delays occur when the road closes and has direct impacts to residents by limiting access to homes and businesses.



Objectives

The County is seeking community input to improve Quarry Road at the low water crossing over Spring Valley Creek to provide more reliable access for traveling public and emergency services to the community impacted by the frequent flooding.
