

Haul Route Conditions

1. Applicant shall agree to repair any County Maintained road(s) damaged by heavy trucks/loads on the haul route. An agreement shall be executed which will include: a cash deposit for emergency and permanent road repairs. This amount shall be sufficient to ensure adequate repairs to the haul route until completion.
2. Truck types, capacity, number of trips per day, estimated quantity of import and export, destination, duration of the haul and hours of operation shall be stated under the agreement.
This information is stated below:
3. Start date of the import/export:
4. Condition of the road(s) shall be determined before and after the haul and provided to the County.
5. County maintained roads shall be swept each day at the end of each work shift. Haul hours shall be adjusted to reflect this requirement.
6. Equipment and material storage shall not be allowed on the County right of way at any time.
7. Contractor/Developer shall agree to restore the roadway to original condition or better. This requirement shall include but not be limited to: asphalt dikes, berms, swales, concrete cross gutters, and concrete sidewalks.
8. Appropriate Stormwater BMP's shall be implemented and maintained at drainage inlets and as needed.
9. A final walk-through shall be performed with the Road Crew Supervisor after the haul is completed.
