

## Organic Waste Disposal Agreement

Agreement between \_\_\_\_\_ ("Business") and \_\_\_\_\_ ("Contractor") for Maintenance of Landscape Areas in Compliance with Mandatory Organics Waste Recycling Requirements in State Laws AB 1826 & SB 1383, and the County of San Diego's Solid Waste Ordinance

California's Mandatory Commercial Organics Recycling Law (AB 1826) requires businesses generating 2 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week to recycle organic waste. AB 1826 has since been superseded by California's Short-Lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Strategy (SB 1383) and the County of San Diego's Solid Waste Ordinance, which require generators to separate organic waste for recycling.

Whereas, Business has contracted with Contractor for the maintenance of landscaping at the business or multi-family property located at \_\_\_\_\_

Now therefore, Contractor agrees to manage and dispose of all Landscape Materials in compliance with California Assembly Bill 1826, Senate Bill 1383, and the County of San Diego Solid Waste Ordinance regulations which require the separation of organic materials from other waste for the purpose of composting, mulching, anaerobic digestion, or other recycling/landfill diversion.

Contractor agrees to keep Landscaping Material separate from other trash or recyclables, including litter that may be found in Business landscape areas.

If Option 3 is selected, Contractor agrees to provide to Business proof of lawful disposal of Landscape Materials upon request. Such proof will include receipts from the Organic Material Recycling Facility showing the date and quantity of materials from the Business that were delivered. A completed County of San Diego Self-Haul Recycling Form along with receipts must be made available to a County Recycling Specialist or Consultant upon request.

"Landscape Materials" shall include grass clippings, tree trimmings, shrub pruning, other plant/landscape materials, and non-hazardous wood waste generated at the Business. Materials such as paper, plastic, glass, or litter are considered contaminants and shall not be placed in containers holding landscape materials.
