  - The Chair highlighted the success of the Fix-It Clinic held at South Bay Earth Day (4/6).
  - A list of upcoming events were shared, including: Fix-It Clinic at Second Chance Beer Company (4/13),
     Zero Waste International Dialogue through Zoom (4/19), and 30th Annual EarthFair at Balboa Park (4/28).
  - Interest in hosting a discussion on single-use plastics with the CRRA technical council. Chair requested information on potential speakers.

## 4. Staff Reports

- City of San Diego
  - o The City continues implementing the Polystyrene Foam and Single Use Plastics Ordinance.
  - The City clarified that the Franchise fee and the AB 939 fees are the responsibility of the hauler and not of the customer.
  - The City attended the Food Waste Forum held by the City of Encinitas (4/6).
- County
  - The County continues implementing the Strategic Plan to Reduce Waste. The stakeholder outreach meeting to discuss proposed changes to the construction and demolition recycling ordinance was held March 20. The next stakeholder outreach meeting to discuss proposed changes to the non-exclusive franchise hauler agreements is tentatively scheduled for April 2019. The County is also working with Planning and Development Services to propose zoning revisions related to organics materials management.
  - o County continues to review the County Facility Diversion Report.
  - o County is planning for a tire amnesty event in Lincoln Acres.
- Haulers- No report.
- I Love a Clean San Diego
  - A list of upcoming events were shared, including: Julian Community Cleanup (4/13), Vista Oil Filter Exchange Event (4/20), Alpine Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event (4/27).
- LWV
  - o A meeting is scheduled with an attorney to discuss the People's Ordinance.

# 7. Legislative Update

- AB 215: would create a new misdemeanor crime for the fourth or subsequent conviction of illegal dumping on private property punishable by imprisonment in a county jail for up to 30 days and a fine of \$750-\$3,000
- AB 257: would create a 5-year woody biomass rural county collection and disposal pilot program
- **AB 792:** would establish a set of graduated minimum recycled content levels for all plastic beverage containers, starting at 25% in 2021
- AB 1171: would prohibit a jurisdiction from requiring a grocery store to use a certain type of food
  packaging unless the material was accepted the local curbside recycling or composting program and
  would prohibit a jurisdiction from prohibiting a grocery store from using a certain type of food packaging
  if the material was accepted in the local curbside program
- **AB 1236:** would require the State Air Resources Board to develop a carbon offset protocol for recycled product manufacturing by January 1, 2022.
- **SB 54 & AB 1080:** would require CalRecycle to adopt regulations to source reduce and recycle at least 75% of single-use plastic packaging and products sold in California by 2030.
