Welcome and Introductions – Debbie Dodson (Carton Council), Bob Hill (EDCO), Beryl Flom (League of Women Voters San Diego), Chase Wiegand (City of San Diego), Ellyn Law (County of San Diego), Steve Weihe (County of San Diego), Stephen Mergener (Scalvage & Zero Waste San Diego), Rick Anthony (Chair)
2. Approval, Minutes Jan 2020 – Approved; No changes.
3. Chair's Report
  - National Recycling Coalition's Zero Waste Conference (March 18-19) has been postponed.
  - The Balboa Park EarthFair event has been postponed. The new event date is tentatively scheduled for September 13<sup>th</sup>.
4. Staff Reports
  - City of San Diego- No report.
  - County of San Diego
    - The County highlighted the success of the Used Oil Filter Exchange Events held on March 7<sup>th</sup> at five AutoZone store locations in Fallbrook, Lakeside, Ramona, and Spring Valley.
    - Updates on the County's Construction and Demolition Recycling Ordinance were passed by the Board of Supervisors on February 12<sup>th</sup>. The new Ordinance measures take effect April 1.
    - The County continues to negotiate proposed changes to the non-exclusive franchise hauler agreements.
    - The County and Cities of San Diego and Chula Vista are interested in collaborating in a regionwide effort to create consistent messaging and graphics to promote recycling correctly and reducing contamination.   - Haulers
    - EDCO is in process of constructing 2 anaerobic digesters at the Escondido Facility. Anticipated completion in January 2021.
  - Carton Council
    - Carton Council is interested in developing new outreach strategies and expanding relationships with community partners.
    - Attendees discussed MRF investments for robotics technology.
  - Zero Waste San Diego
    - Zero Waste highlighted the success of the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Zero Waste Symposium which included information sessions with 29 speakers!

- LWV
  - The League may postpone the food waste educational program.
  - The League and ZWSD are continuing the effort to repeal the People's Ordinance.

7. Legislative Update

- [AB 1952](#): *Washing machines: microfiber filters: state laundry facilities: pilot program*. This bill would require the Department of General Services, in coordination with the California Environmental Protection Agency, to implement a pilot program for one year to assess the efficacy of microfiber filtration systems in removing microfiber from waste washwater from state-owned laundry facilities.
- [AB 2612](#): *Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund: recycling: appropriation*. This bill would, beginning fiscal year 2020-2021 continuously appropriate \$100,000,000 from the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund annually to CalRecycle for in-state organic waste recycling projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions and achieve certain organic waste disposal goals.
- [SB 1191](#): *Organic waste: reduction goals: local jurisdictions*. This bill would require CalRecycle, in determining whether to issue a compliance order or impose a penalty on a local jurisdiction, or in determining the amount of any penalties, related to SB 1383 compliance to consider whether a jurisdiction has made a good faith effort to implement its organic waste reduction program and whether any specified factors affected the local jurisdiction's ability to implement its organic waste reduction program.
