#### 3. REVIEW OF THE AUGUST 4, 2022 MEETING SUMMARY

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

**Steve Morris, I Love a Clean San Diego:** Join I Love a Clean San Diego for the 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Coastal Cleanup Day on September 17 from 9am-12pm.

#### 5. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

**Eric Wolff, County of San Diego:** The Board of Supervisors unanimously approved updates to the zoning ordinance related to organic materials management. A second hearing is scheduled for September 14. San Diego EarthWorks announced that EarthFair 2022 this past April was the last.

**Natalia King, County of San Diego:** Natalia provided an overview of the County's waiver program for <u>residents</u> and <u>commercial and multi-family premises with 5+units</u> in the densely-populated unincorporated areas. #### 6. PRESENTATION

**Jake DeFOe, BDP Industries:** <u>BDP Industries</u> is a design and manufacturing business that provides solid/liquid separation and composting technologies to industries and municipalities. Roberta Goldenpenny, CalRecycle: Roberta reported on the following:

- The EAR is due 10/3 and has been restructured for SB 1383. There is a third webinar for Q&A on 9/1 at 2pm.
- An update on grant/loan opportunities was shared including Tire Derived Grant Program (applications due 12/7/22), Farm and Ranch Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grant Program (applications due 11/10/22 & 2/9/23), Rubberized Pavement Grant Program (applications due 10/12/22), Community Composting for Green Spaces Grant Program (applications due 10/20/22), and Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program (applications due 10/18/22).
- The <u>Illegal Disposal Site Abatement Grant Program</u> provides funds to assist with solid waste cleanup and abatement measures for inactive homeless encampments. The CA Department of Transportation also provides grant funds to assist with homeless camp litter abatement through the <u>Clean California Local Grant Program</u>.
- The next CalRecycle public meeting is 9/20.

- AB 847, Electrically conductive balloons. On Governor's desk.
- AB 1067, Beverage containers. Dead.
- **SB 38**, Beverage containers. On Governor's desk.
- <u>SB 45</u>, Short-lived climate pollutants: organic waste reduction goals: local jurisdiction assistance. On Governor's desk.
- <u>SB 54</u>, Solid waste: reporting, packaging, and plastic food service ware. Signed by the Governor 6/30.
- <u>SB 451</u>, Beverage container recycling: pilot program. Dead, provisions rolled into SB 1013.

- AB 1793, Hazardous waste: identification: acute aquatic toxicity criterion. On Governor's desk.
