#### 3. REVIEW OF THE SEPTEMBER 1, 2022 MEETING SUMMARY

Colleen Foster, City of Oceanside motioned to approve the September 1, 2022 Meeting Summary. Hilary Ego, City of La Mesa seconded. <u>Motion carried</u> to approve the Meeting Summary.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

**Mallika Sen, Solana Center:** Solana Center has a variety of upcoming English and Spanish webinars including Intro to Vermicomposting, Smart Ways to Fight Food Waste, and Backyard Composting Basics. Event details are available at <u>solanacenter.org/events</u>. Solana Center continues to engage in community outreach events, provide inspections and technical

consultations for various jurisdictions and recently rolled out a lunch waste sorting program for the Dehesa School District.

#### 6. PRESENTATION

Matthew Clough, Plastic Beach: Plastic Beach is a non-profit organization that facilitates preconsumer plastic film materials recycling for businesses. Plastic Beach is currently working with 7 retail and distribution locations to collect and recycle approximately 1,000 pounds of film plastic each month. Plastic Beach currently bales material and transports it to Riverside County for processing and is interested in connecting with local haulers that may be able to accept these film bales. **Bob Hollis, SMART1383:** Smart1383.com is an online platform that is designed to integrate data and recordkeeping functions for entities that manage solid waste programs. Features include an SB1383 base model that provides a robust platform for tracking items needed for SB 1383 compliance including route reviews, data collection, analytics, and reporting.

## 7. CALRECYCLE UPDATE

Roberta Goldenpenny, CalRecycle: Roberta reported on the following:

- Thank you for submitting your 2021 EAR.
- LAMD staff are restarting site visits and will be scheduling times to meet with jurisdiction solid waste and recycling staff.
- Capacity planning reports were due to CalRecycle 8/1/22. Jurisdictions are responsible for submitting an implementation schedule to CalRecycle when capacity is lacking.
- An update on grant/loan opportunities was shared including Rubberized Pavement Grant Program (Applications due 10/12/22), Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program (Applications due 10/18/22), Community Composting for Green Spaces Grant Program (10/20/22), Farm and Ranch Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grant Program (Applications due 11/10/22 and 2/9/23), Tire Derived Aggregate Grant Program (Applications due 12/7/22), Illegal Disposal Site Abatement Grant Program (Applications due 2/15/23), Legacy Disposal Site Abatement Partial Grant Program (Applications due 2/15/23).
- The next CalRecycle public meeting is 10/18.

- Upcoming events include 2022 CalRecycle Tire Conference (11/2-11/3) and Discussion of Revising the Five-Year Tire Plan (11/30).
- **8. CPSC UPDATE** No update.

#### 9. LEGISLATION

**Eric Wolff, County of San Diego:** Eric shared an update on the following bills approved by the Governor:

- <u>SB 1013</u>, Beverage container recycling. This bill expands the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act to include wine bottles and distilled spirit containers.
- AB 1857, Solid waste. This bill removes the 10% diversion credit for transformation tons.
- <u>SB 1215</u>, Electronic Waste Recycling Act of 2003: covered battery-embedded products. This bill expands California's electronic waste recycling program to cover products that contain and embedded battery.
- <u>AB 2440</u>, Responsible Battery Recycling Act of 2022. This bill requires producers to establish a stewardship program for the collection and recycling of covered batteries.
- AB 1985, Organic waste: recovered organic waste product procurement targets. This bill requires any penalties imposed by CalRecycle that fails to meet its recovered organic waste procurement target to be imposed on a specified schedule based on the percentage of the local jurisdiction's recovered organic waste product procurement target achieved.
- <u>SB 1046</u>, Solid waste: precheckout and carryout bags. This bill prohibits stores from providing a precheckout bag to a customer if the bag is not either a compostable bag or a recycled bag after January 1, 2025.

The following bills were vetoed by the Governor:

- <u>AB 2784</u>, Solid waste: thermoform plastic containers: postconsumer thermoform recycled plastic. This bill would have required the total thermoform plastic containers sold or imported by a producer to contain specified amounts of postconsumer thermoform recycled plastic on a tiered plan.
- <u>SB 1256</u>, Waste management: disposable propane cylinders. This bill would have prohibited the sale of disposable propane cylinders by January 1, 2028.

**Colleen Foster, City of Oceanside**: Colleen noted impacts on infrastructure and collection routes from driver shortages.
