1. QUORUM

2. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

3. REVIEW OF THE DECEMBER 2, 2021 AND JANUARY 6, 2022 MEETING SUMMARIES

Hilary Ego, City of La Mesa motioned to approve the December 2, 2021 and January 6, 2022 Meeting Summaries. Annika Andersen, City of Oceanside seconded. Motion carried to approve the Meeting Summaries.

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Jake DeFoe, BDP Industries – BDP Industries manufactures wastewater treatment and composting equipment for industries and municipalities.

Emily Creegan – Interest in open positions related to SB 1383.

5. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego – The County is interested in developing Oops Tag outreach materials and asked if other jurisdictions had resources to share.

6. PRESENTATION

Jayson Martin, ARCA Recycling: [ARCA Recycling](#) offers an array of appliance recycling and replacement programs with 16 recycling centers serving 29 states and is interested in partnering with organizations in the San Diego region. In the past 40 years, ARCA has recycled 5 million appliances in North America including 1 million appliances recycled and 350,000 appliances replaced in California.
