3. REVIEW OF THE MARCH 3, 2022 MEETING SUMMARY

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Jessica Toth, Solana Center for Environmental Innovation: Solana Center continues to provide SB 1383 services for jurisdictions and are interested in sharing the results of their desktop and onsite analyses at a future meeting.

Manuel Medrano, City of Chula Vista: South Bay Earth Day is April 9th from 11am-4pm at Memorial Park in Chula Vista.

Laura Anthony, Zero Waste San Diego: Upcoming San Diego Fixit Clinic <u>Events</u> were shared including La Mesa Earth Day (4/9), South Bay Earth Day (4/9), Carlsbad (4/16), and Encinitas (4/30).

Steve Morris, I Love a Clean San Diego: The 20th annual <u>Creek to Bay Cleanup</u> is scheduled for April 26th and includes nearly 75 cleanup sites around San Diego County.

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: Eric thanked Sean Harris for his involvement in the TAC as he will be leaving the group. The County is hosting a Facebook Live <u>Ask A Recycling Specialist</u> — Food Scraps Edition event on April 22 in celebration of Earth Day.

7. CALRECYCLE UPDATE

Haley Aumiller, CalRecycle - Haley reported on the following:

- CalRecycle published new <u>Q&As</u> on the SB 1383 requirements for the procurement of recovered organic waste products and recycled-content paper.
- Other webpage updates include the <u>Technologies: Within-Vessel Composting</u> and <u>Commercial-Scale Technologies: Food Scraps Management</u>
- The Electronic Annual Report is due by October 1, 2022 and jurisdictions may submit earlier if they choose.
- The SB 1383 Recycling and Disposal Reporting System Reporting Requirements Starting in 2022 Part II webinar recording and presentation are available here.
- CalRecycle is hosting the SB 1383 Procurement Requirements Webinar on May 3.
- Co-Digestion Grant Program applications are due May 19th.
- The next CalRecycle public meeting is on April 19th.

- <u>SB 1256</u>, Waste management: disposable propane cylinders Hearing on 4/19/22. In Senate Judiciary.
