4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Mallika Sen, Solana Center: Solana Center continues to hold zero waste and food waste reduction workshops and recently completed a master composter series. A full list of upcoming events is available on the Solana Center website: solanacenter.org/free-compost-workshops. The Healthy Soils program had 15 applicants, 7 of whom finished the application and 6 that were awarded.

5. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: The County is reaching out to food recovery agencies regarding the survey to identify if there is additional capacity available.

6. PRESENTATION

Murtaza Baxamusa, County of San Diego: Murtaza provided an overview of the Regional Decarbonization Framework (RDF) which is a partnership with the UC San Diego School of Global Policy and Strategy and the University of San Diego Energy Policy Initiatives Center, and Inclusive Economics to move the region toward zero-carbon emissions.
