1. QUORUM

The Chair determined that quorum was met and called the meeting to order.

2. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

3. REVIEW OF THE JULY 7, 2022 MEETING SUMMARY

Collen Foster, City of Oceanside motioned to approve the July 7, 2022 Meeting Summary. Avecita Jones, City of Carlsbad seconded. <u>Motion carried to approve the Meeting Summary</u>.

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Mallika Sen, Solana Center: Solana Center continues to schedule SB 1383 inspections and provide technical assistance for various cities and will be relaunching the school lunch waste program which slowed down at the end of the school year. A list of upcoming events was also shared including the All About Worms Workshop (8/13), Achieving your zero waste potential webinar (8/31), SB 1383 compliance commercial food waste prevention webinar (9/8), Raising backyard chickens workshop (9/10) and the master composter course (9/17). 5. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: Eric thanked all the jurisdictions and food recovery organizations for their collaboration and submittal of capacity planning information. The County submitted the Capacity Planning Report to CalRecycle on August 1.

6. PRESENTATION

Abbie Beane, Carpet America Recovery Effort (CARE): CARE serves as the designated carpet stewardship organization for California and is responsible for meeting the requirements of California's carpet recycling laws. CARE works to advance market-based solutions that increase landfill diversion and recycling of post-consumer carpet and encourage the design for recyclability. California's carpet stewardship program currently includes 103 public drop-off sites and achieved a 28% carpet recycling rate in 2021. - <u>SB 1215</u>, Battery and Battery-Embedded Product Recycling and Fire Risk Reduction Act of 2022 in Assembly Approps on Suspense.
- SB 1256, Waste management: disposable propane cylinders. On Assembly Floor.
- SB 38, Beverage containers. In Assembly Approps on Suspense.
- SB 54, Plastic Pollution Producer Responsibility Act. Signed by the Governor 6/30/22.
- <u>AB 1985</u>, Organic waste: recovered organic waste product procurement targets. Hearing in Senate Approps on 8/8/22.

- AB 2779, Beverage containers: wine and distilled spirits. In Senate Approps on suspense.
- <u>SB 1013</u>, Beverage container recycling: reports: electronic submittal: wine and distilled spirits. In Assembly Approps on Suspense.
- AB 2784, Solid waste: thermoform plastic containers: postconsumer thermoform recycled plastic. Hearing in Senate Approps on 8/8/22.
- SB 1187, Fabric recycling: pilot project. In Assembly Approps on Suspense.

Avecita Jones, City of Carlsbad: The City is transitioning services to a new waste hauler and is in the process of rolling out organic collection services.

12. TARP YOUR LOAD/LITTER ABATEMENT – OPPORTUNITIES TO UNIFY OUTREACH

The <u>Illegal Dumping Technical Advisory Committee</u> provides expertise for CalRecycle and the state on issues, best practices, and strategies to address illegal dumping.

13. SUBCOMITTEES' REPORT

- **a.** Household Hazardous Waste No report. Attendees discussed used oil filter exchange events.
- b. Organics The County of San Diego Planning & Development Services has been working on updates to the County's zoning ordinance related to organic material processing. On July 22, the Planning Commission unanimously recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the updates. The County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on the Ordinance Amendments on August 31. Evergreen Nursery has been sold to a new operator and their sites are no longer accepting organic materials from offsite. UCCE is filling a position for a Southern California Organic Materials Management Specialist.
- **c. Edible Food Recovery** Attendees discussed the County capacity report submittal. Interest in the County's Live Well San Diego Equitable Communities food insecurity initiative.
