- Staff Reports
  - City of San Diego
    - Currently rolling out organic waste bins to residents with Wednesday collectionwill be serviced the same day as trash bins
    - o July/August timeline for Citywide green bin rollout

- Delivery of organic waste bins are being paired with City Recycling Specialists to answer any questions
- Webinars will accompany green bin roll out

- New organic waste website- www.organicwasterecyclingsd.org
  - Coincides with new marketing strategy (billboards/press release/TV/ etc)
- o Attendees discussed private haulers and organic waste roll out
  - Sizes of organic waste bins available
    - 95/65/35 gallon
    - Larger homes will get a larger bin
  - Resident supplied organic waste bins will no longer be collected (no more manual collection)
- City's Single Use Plastics Ordinance goes into effect on 4/23/23
  - Bans Styrofoam from food service businesses
  - Mandates "upon request" for items like straws/utensils
  - An education and outreach campaign will take place for city businesses (webinar and in person)
- Privately serviced business required to have organic waste recycling through hauler
  - A website about the Single Use Plastic Ordinance will be added
- o Contractors will help supplement outreach with educational booths/outreach
- School/Public landfill tours are now an option again

## County of San Diego

- Staff continue to conduct outreach and site visits to commercial and multifamily complex units regarding mandatory recycling and organic waste
- Discussed blue and green bin rollout in the unincorporated county to residential, commercial and multifamily properties
- Next month County will be presenting our regional capacity study
