**1. QUORUM**

The Chair determined that quorum was met and called the meeting to order.

**2. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS**

Jurisdiction representatives and guests introduced themselves.

**3. REVIEW OF THE JANUARY 5, 2023 MEETING SUMMARY – Reviewed. No comments.**

**4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS**

**Stephen Mergener, Zero Waste San Diego:** Upcoming [Fix-It Clinics](#) include Lemon Grove (1/14), Chula Vista (1/28), and Carlsbad (2/25). The 10<sup>th</sup> annual [Zero Waste Symposium](#) will be held February 21<sup>st</sup>. Early bird registration ends January 16<sup>th</sup>.

**Mallika Sen, Solana Center for Environmental Innovation:** Solana Center continues to conduct inspections and technical consultations related to SB 1383. Solana Center completed a waste audit for the Manzanita tribe and is currently working with the Poway Unified School District to implement food donation programs.

**Steve Morris and Amy Unruh, I Love a Clean San Diego:** A list of [upcoming events](#) was shared including Casa De Oro Cleanup (1/14), Navajo Canyon Cleanup (1/19), Sustainable Landscaping Webinar (1/19), Step Up Your Sustainability Webinar (1/25), Conscious Closets Webinar (2/8), and Say No To Single Use Plastic Webinar (1/16).

## 5. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

**Eric Wolff, County of San Diego:** The TAC meeting will be held in person for members with an option for virtual attendance for guests moving forward. An overview of the public meeting requirements under the Brown Act was shared.

## 6. PRESENTATION

**Heather Buonomo, County of San Diego:** The County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health and Quality (DEHQ) is a full cost recovery program that implements the California Retail Food Code. The County Department of Public Works implements SB 1383 for the unincorporated areas. Heather provided an overview of DEHQ's role related to SB 1383. ## 7. CALRECYCLE UPDATE

**Jill Larner, CalRecycle:** Jill reported on the following:

- Roberta Goldenpenny is no longer with CalRecycle. LAMD contacts are currently Jill Firch, Emily Schuetz and Jill Larner. The CalRecycle local contacts website will be updated shortly.
- CalRecycle has held 2 monthly chats on SB 1383. Chat recordings are available on CalRecycle's YouTube page. Upcoming chats on multifamily properties for SB 1383 compliance are on 1/18 and 2/15.
- CalRecycle hosted a webinar for jurisdictions on the iRecycleSmart Statewide Education Campaign, including details on the Toolkit for Jurisdictions and the Food Scrap campaign on 12/7/22. The recorded training is available on CalRecycle's [YouTube page](#). There will be 3 additional trainings tailored to jurisdictions on Digital & Social Best Practices (1/11), Pilot Program Finds (1/18), and Influencer Insights & Best practices (1/25).
- CalRecycle has released a new recorded [training](#) on the SB 1383 facility requirements. There are 3 live Q&A sessions planned to discuss any questions on the facility requirements. Sessions will be held 1/10, 1/12 and 2/2.
- An update on [grant/loan opportunities](#) was shared including Organics Grant Program (Cycle 7 is coming up), Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program (Applications due 1/17), Farm and Ranch Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grant

- Program (Applications due 2/9), Illegal Disposal Site Abatement Grant Program (Applications due 2/15), Legacy Disposal Site Abatement Partial Grant Program (2/15).
- The next CalRecycle monthly public meeting is 1/17.

## 8. CPSC UPDATE

**Doug Kobold, CPSC:** There were nearly 4,500 bills introduced and 55 bills signed in the 2021-2022 legislative session. 2022 Signed bills include:

- AB 1857, Solid Waste (Transformation Diversion)
- AB 2208, Fluorescent lamps: sale and distribution: prohibition (sales ban)
- AB 2374, Crimes against public health and safety: illegal dumping
- AB 2440, Responsible Battery Recycling Act of 2022
- AB 2481, Household hazardous waste: facilities: transportation and acceptance
- SB 38, beverage containers
- SB 54, Solid waste: reporting, packaging, and plastic food service ware
- SB 1013, Beverage container recycling
- SB 1187, Fabric recycling: pilot project
- SB 1215, Electronic Waste Recycling Act of 2003

**Colleen Foster, City of Oceanside:** Interest in future discussion on what legislative topics jurisdictions are interested in.

**Polina Osipova, City of San Diego:** Organic waste collection services for households serviced by the City will begin in January 2023 and will continue as a phased rollout, with completion expected by mid-2023.

**Avecita Jones, City of Carlsbad:** Avecita asked the group if any jurisdictions started completing contamination checks.

**Risa Barron, Republic Services:** Risa noted that plastic bags are a major contaminant in the recycling stream and coordinated messaging across the jurisdictions would be beneficial.
