# **Meeting Summary**

# 1. QUORUM

- 3. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Jurisdiction representatives and guests introduced themselves.

- **4. REVIEW OF THE FEBRUARY 2, 2023 MEETING SUMMARY** Reviewed. No comments.
- 5. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

**Stephen Mergener, Zero Waste San Diego:** Thank you to those that participated in the 10<sup>th</sup> annual Zero Waste Symposium! The event included 200 in-person attendees and 50 virtual attendees with 25 speakers discussing an array of sustainability topics. A list of upcoming <u>Fixit Clinics</u> was also shared including San Diego Lemon Grove (3/11) and Carlsbad (4/1).

Mallika Sen, Solana Center for Environmental Innovation: The Solana Center is conducting extensive education and outreach with the City of San Diego to support the organic materials collection rollout. Solana Center also had the opportunity to share insight on SB 1383 programming at the SWANA and CalRecycle March webinar. Solana Center will be starting inspections for tier 2 commercial edible food generators. A full list of upcoming public outreach events is available on Solana Center's website.

# **6. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT** – No report.

#### 7. PRESENTATION

**Eric Wolff, County of San Diego:** Preliminary results of the County's Processing Facility Capacity Study was shared. The County surveyed facilities that process recyclable, organic and construction and demolition materials to understand existing processing capacity and assess, if and when, additional capacity will be needed in the future. The white paper is still in draft form and is anticipated to be shared with the Board of Supervisors on June 28. For more information, please contact Eric at Eric.Wolff@sdcounty.ca.gov.

#### 8. CALRECYCLE UPDATE

**Jill Firch, CalRecycle:** Jill reported on the following:

- CalRecycle is hosting a SB 1383 chat with a focus on multifamily dwellings on 3/15. The
  April chat will focus on local education agencies. Recordings of past webinars are
  available on CalRecycle's YouTube channel.
- CalRecycle Jurisdiction and Agency Compliance and Enforcement Branch is completing EAR reviews. LAMD staff will follow up with any identified technical assistance when they complete conference calls for the jurisdictions.
- The 2022 EAR will be released in June with a due date to CalRecycle by August 1, 2023. CalRecycle will hold a training webinar prior to June.
- CalRecycle continues to work with jurisdictions with an approved notification of intent to comply through the SB 619 process to develop their corrective action plans.
- CalRecycle began SB 1383 compliance evaluations. Notifications will be sent out prior to the evaluation. Every jurisdiction will be reviewed in the next four years.
- CalRecycle hosted four webinars in December and January on the I Recycle Smart Campaign. The training recordings and presentations are available on the Jurisdiction Toolkit webpage.
- An update on <u>grant/loan opportunities</u> was shared including Organics Grant Program (applications due 4/20), Greenhouse Gas Reduction Loan Program (continuous applications), Recycling Market Development Zone Loan Program (continuous applications), Redemption Pilot Project Program (continuous applications).
- The next CalRecycle public meeting is scheduled for March 21.

Ellyn Law, County of San Diego: Ellyn shared an update on the following bill:

• SB 707, Responsible Textile Recovery Act of 2023 – This bill would establish a stewardship program for the collection and recycling of any apparel, textile, or textile article that is unsuitable for reuse by a consumer in its current condition.

**Michael Luna, City of Del Mar:** Del Mar completed their SB 1383 rollout for commercial customers. IWMTAC members discussed waivers and potential appeal processes.

**Colleen Foster, City of Oceanside:** Colleen noted that it would be helpful to have a share table on how jurisdictions are planning on addressing enforcement.

**Michael Luna, City of Del Mar:** Michael asked the group how jurisdictions' internal agreements on purchases were going.

**IWMTAC Members:** IWMTAC members discussed implementation record files.

**Polina Osipova, City of San Diego:** The City continues the residential organics collection rollout. The City's Single Use Plastic Reduction Ordinance goes into effect April 1, 2023.
