Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: None

7. PRESENTATION

Emily Creegan, City of San Diego: Emily presented the City's Organic Waste Recycling Campaign. The campaign was geared towards residents and business to increase awareness and facilitate behavior change to introduce the green organics bin and how to use it. The City worked with consultants to develop a new campaign website, online partner toolkit, and various ad designs including truck signs, outdoor billboards, bus shelter ads, event banners, social media posts, audio streaming ads, videos and newspaper ads. Additional education and outreach efforts include customer lid flips and cart tags, Miramar Greenery visual checks, surveys, focus groups, stakeholder interview and media analysis. 8. CALRECYCLE UPDATE

Jill Larner, CalRecycle: Jill reported on the following:

- CalRecycle is hosting a SB 1383 chat with a focus on collaboration and program implementation for local education agencies on April 19.
- AB 661 was approved by the Governor on September 25, 2022, which adds new recycling-related requirements under the Public Contract Code.
- The 2022 Electronic Annual Report will be released in June. CalRecycle will hold a training webinar on the report prior to June. Details will be shared as they become available.
- CalRecycle has I Recycle Smart campaign <u>resources</u> available for jurisdictions.
- An update on <u>grant/loan opportunities</u> was shared including Local Conservation Corps Grant Program (applications due 4/6/23), Local Government Waste Tire Amnesty Grant Program (applications due 4/6/23), Organics Grant Program (4/20/23), Greenhouse Gas Reduction Loan Program (continuous), Recycling Market Development Loan Program (continuous), redemption pilot project program (continuous).
- The next CalRecycle public meeting is on April 18.

IWMTAC members had the following questions:

- Colleen Foster, City of Oceanside: Colleen asked if there was an update on the SB 1383 payment program.
- Michael Luna, City of Del Mar: Michael requested an update on an information request for SB 1383 enforcement on non-local entities.
- Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: Eric requested information on the authority for jurisdictions to conduct inspections on non-local entities.
- **9. CPSC UPDATE** No report. There is a hybrid in-person/virtual Illegal Dumping Conference April 19-21.
- **10. LEGISLATION** No update.

11. SB 1383 & AB 1826- ROLLOUT ROUNDTABLE

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: Eric asked the group if any jurisdictions had less than a 3-bin system.

Michael Luna, City of Del Mar: SB 613 was introduced on February 15 which would exempt a local jurisdiction from certain SB 1383 requirements if the jurisdiction disposes of less than 5,000 tons of solid waste per year and has less than 7,500 people.

Samantha Byfield, City of San Marcos: Samantha asked the group how jurisdictions are capturing new potential tier 1 and 2 businesses to add to their SB 1383 program. Suggestions included engaging the Planning Department or Economic Development Division, and /or hauler.

Michael Luna, City of Del Mar: Michael provided an update on the appeal process for SB 1383 waivers. The City is now 100% compliant!

Serena Lee, City of La Mesa: Interest in a calculator to determine amount of organic waste generated per tenant in multifamily complexes.
