Caitlin Barboza, County of San Diego: The Integrated Waste Management Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) meetings were established by the Board of Supervisors in partnership with the San Diego Association of Governments for the purpose of preparing the Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan (CIWMP).
