- Major grading projects do **NOT** require a performance guarantee but **DO** require a Debris Management Plan
- Performance Guarantee is \$0.40 per square foot not to exceed \$40,000

**REQUIREMENT:** 65% diversion of C&D generated by construction and demolition projects, which shall include:

- 90% minimum diversion of inert material.
- 100% of excavated soils, trees, stumps, rocks, and associated vegetation from major grading projects is required.

Each log entry shall correspond with a receipt issued by the party that transported the material off-site or by facility that accepted the materials if they were self-hauled by permittee. The daily log and all receipts shall be maintained at the project site and made available to any County inspector or DMP compliance official. Pictures, donation or sales receipts and other proof of material reuse /salvage must be submitted along with the Final DMP. Major grading projects must submit a certification letter that summarizes the material types, total weights and facilities used to divert material.

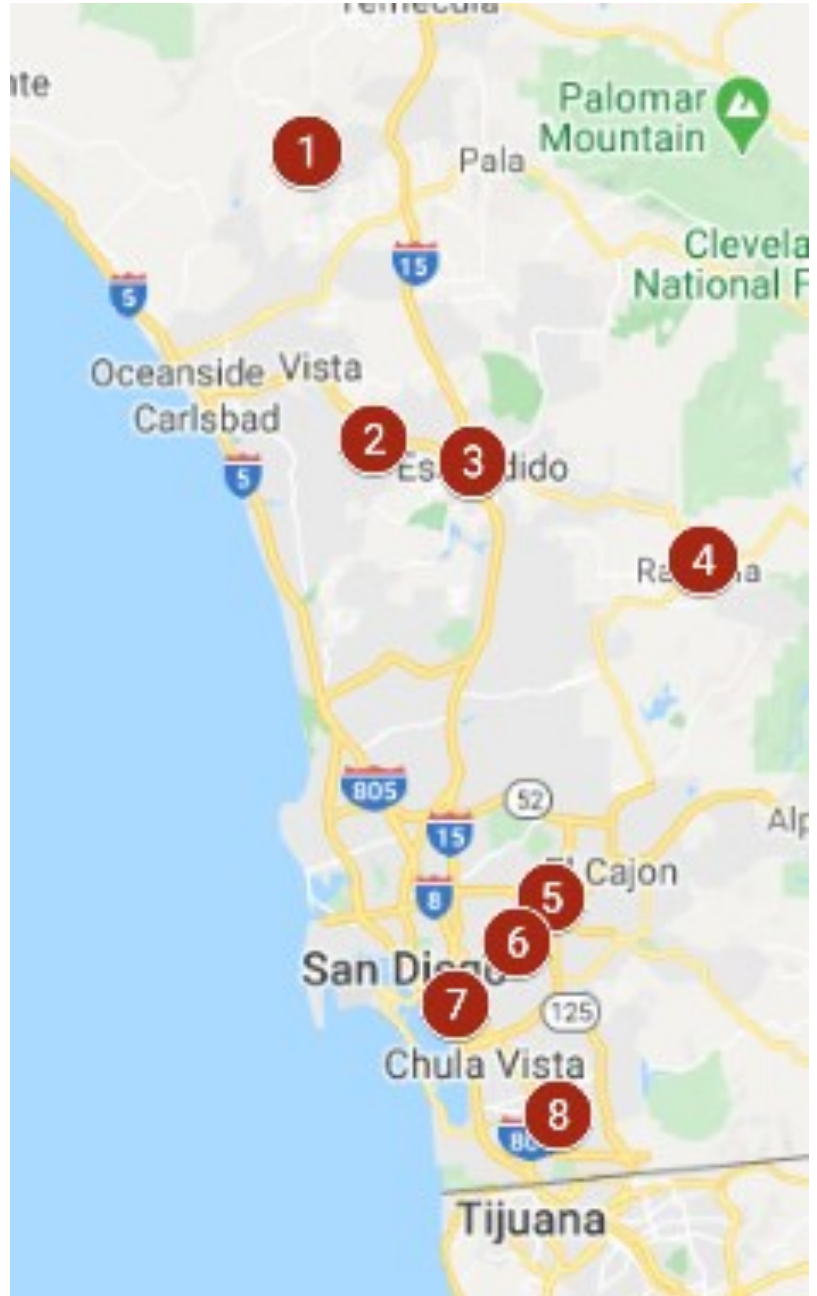
