APPLICATION FOR <u>SINGLE-FAMILY PREMISES</u> IN UNINCORPORATED SAN DIEGO COUNTY

Background Information

Owners or occupants of single-family residential premises (including multi-family premises with 4 or less units) in unincorporated San Diego County are required to comply with organics materials recycling requirements of the County Code. These requirements include separating and recycling designated recyclable and organic materials and subscribing to solid waste, recyclable and organic materials collection services from a qualified provider. Subscribing to collection services may be waived if the premises' responsible party is granted a waiver, self-hauls recyclable and/or organic materials to a facility that reuses, salvages, recycles, or processes the materials, or meets exemption criteria of the County's municipal code.

Waivers Available for Single-Family Premises (includes Multi-Family residential premises with 4 or less units)		
Type of Waiver	Criteria	
On-site organics management waiver	The organic material generated at applicant's property is being managed through on-site composting or other on-site management practices that are consistent with applicable laws or regulations. Designated organic materials may not be placed in the solid waste or recycling container.	

Densely and sparsely-populated areas


Densely-populated areas of the County are those with census tracts with 75+ people per square mile. Residents in the densely-populated areas must comply with <u>all</u> recycling requirements, unless registered as a self-hauler or granted a waiver.

Sparsely-populated areas of the County are those with census tracts with less than 75 people per square mile. Single-family premises in the sparsely-populated areas are categorically exempt from the recycling of food scraps and food-soiled paper. Therefore, registering as a self-hauler or applying for a waiver for the recycling of food scraps and food-soiled paper is not necessary.

How to apply for a waiver from the County of San Diego

To apply for a waiver from the requirement to subscribe to organic materials collection service, the following steps must be completed:

- 1. The owner or operator of the premises must fill out the information in the form below and provide all documentation required by this form. Alternatively, the owner or operator of the premises must sign the bottom of this form consenting to their solid waste, recyclable materials, and/or organic materials hauler submitting this form on their behalf.
- 2. Email the completed and signed form, along with all required documentation to Recycle@sdcounty.ca.gov.
- 3. Receive a confirmation email from the County that the waiver(s) have been approved or denied. The email will be sent to the email contact on this form.

The County or company providing collection service may verify the applicability of the waiver each year. During this review process, owner or operator of the premises shall update information in this form, upon request.

- 2. Waiver holder must cooperate with the County and/or their hauler for compliance inspections and enforcement as per County Code Section 68.610.
- 3. County may revoke a waiver upon a determination that any of the circumstances justifying a waiver are no longer applicable.
