Fiscal Year Budget 2022/2023: PRD 20 Daily Road

This document contains information regarding the fiscal year 2022/2023 annual budget for Permanent Road Division (PRD) Zone PRD 20 Daily Road.

PRD Budget:

A majority of PRD funds are budgeted each year for both planned road work, and unanticipated/emergency repairs. Information on planned road work, if applicable, is included below. Maintenance Coordinator Staff Time includes the time spent performing field inspections, responding to property owner service requests, developing job estimates, contracting, providing direct maintenance services, and overseeing road work. Administration includes all costs associated with managing the PRD in compliance with State and local laws. It includes the purchase of supplemental liability insurance, financial management of each PRD Zone, annual tax enrollment (applicable for PRDs that charge an assessment/special tax), staff time for service and information requests, telephone call responses, written correspondence, response to complaints, and any other activities requested by property owners.
