

Photo guidance for your Structural BMP(s)

- Confirm that all the components of the structural BMPs are visible.
- Assign an identifying number to each photo. Include the permit number and the BMP Record ID number (provided on Page 1 of your maintenance verification letter).
- Submit at least one photo for each structural BMP. Include photos from multiple angles of the structural BMP if necessary.

Guidance for Drain insert BMPs:

If your drain insert is installed within a catch basin, remove the catch basin grate before taking the photo. This will allow the County inspector to see the inside of the filter unit including the basket and media as applicable. Make sure to reset the grate after taking the photo.

Complete Photo

Guidance for vegetated BMPs:

For vegetated BMPs, capture the BMP in its entirety (include inlet and outlet points, show the feature's contouring, and adjacent slopes).

- Only part of BMP is visible in photo ✗
