## **GIS Extra Legal-Truck Route Tip Sheet**

Using Zoom and Pan tools:



- Zoom In on map location.



- Zoom Out on map location



- Click and hold mouse to **Pan** map to desired location.



- Takes screen to a complete view of San Diego County



Directions tool to define specific legal truck route



- Start Point Find address or place



Find address or place - Finish Point



- Click the route displayed on the map and drag so truck can drive over your streets of preference
- After route is adjusted accordingly, the directions, commute time, and distance will be updated on the left side of the screen
- The left hand side of the screen also has a drop down menu that allows a user to choose whether the truck is leaving now, at a certain time, or if it is unspecified

Use the Measure tool to open the dialog box below









These three tools allow users to find an area, measure a distance, find longitude, and latitude coordinates.

After clicking on the Details tool you are able to CLICK ON ANY LEGAL TRUCK ROUTE..... that opens an interactive text box with details of the road.

Legal truck routes will be displayed on the map as either a green, orange, purple, or a red line.


The interactive text box will have:

- 1. Street Name
- 2. Route Rating
- 3. Maximum Weight Allowed

At the bottom of the text box are 3 hyperlinks

- 1. Displays as "Extra-Legal Truck Route" Weight Charts. This link will redirect you to the orange, green, and purple weight charts on the Caltrans website.
- 2. Zooms to the area of the truck route.
- 3. Directs you to your point of interest and directions tab
