Action Requested of EMCC

 Seeking endorsement from EMCC to renew the Spare Wheel Exemption for a specific exemption from vehicle code-related regulations.





California Code of Regulations

<u>Title 13, Section 1103, Ambulance Emergency Care Equipment and Supplies</u>

- Safety equipment carried or installed in an ambulance, to be maintained in good working order
 - Including a spare wheel along with the tools required to change a wheel and or tire


Title 13, Section 1108, Exemption from Requirements

- Allows an ambulance agency to request an exemption from carrying certain mandatory equipment and or supplies
- Board of Supervisors must endorse an exemption request
- Exemptions may be awarded for up to 2 years













Current Requests

- The EMS Office received exemption requests from three private ambulance agencies that have good cause for approval for public health and safety reasons:
 - American Medical Response, Inc
 - Falck Mobile Health Corporation
 - Mercy Medical Transportation, Inc
