## RE: REDUCTION IN COSD HOSPITAL DATA REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

To decrease the reporting burden on County of San Diego (CoSD) acute care hospitals and align with the current stage of the COVID-19 pandemic, we have removed requirements for some of the currently collected data elements. This information supersedes the previous <u>"Regarding Bed Counts in Acute Care Facilities" memo</u> dated March 27, 2020.

While the local COVID-19 data are improving, the reporting of hospital-level data remains critical for on-going surveillance and early detection of potential future surges.

After removal of some data elements, CoSD EMS requests that the following <u>continue</u> to be reported:

- COVID-19 Patient Data Daily report of 6 questions related to COVID patients and ICU availability
- Imperial County Patient Data Daily report of 4 questions related to patients from Imperial County
- **Hospital Capacity Survey** Complete only when a change occurs in any of the capacity-related elements
- Laboratory Tests Performed Daily report with a single question "How many COVID-19 tests were performed yesterday?"
- Bed Availability Section Daily point in time count of various critical data elements including ED volume, ED Boarders, and the availability of Total Beds, Specific Beds, and Ventilators
- Length of Stay (LOS) Data Survey Weekly report of LOS data for discharged COVID patients. This is reported collectively by health system, not by individual hospitals.

Users in the permission groups Facility Administrators and Facility Users have access to surveys within LEMSIS Resource Bridge. Surveys are located in the drop-down list accessed by clicking your facility's name. For a list of questions included in

each survey, please see the Document Hub for the updated Resource Survey Definitions document.

The reporting of the following surveys, sections, and data elements are discontinued.

- PPE Supply Survey
- Staff Availability Survey
- Skilled Nursing Facility Data (section of COVID-19 Patient Data Survey)
- Available Morgue Space

These data elements may be requested in the future if another COVID-19 surge develops.

The information you are providing is extremely valuable to the County's COVID-19 mitigation and management initiatives. Thank you for your participation in the LEMSIS Resource Bridge system.
