Prearrival Notification Pilots and New ED Diversion Status


- Beginning in March, three digital EMS prearrival notification pilots will test processes to alert receiving EDs of incoming ambulance patients. These pilots are anticipated to continue into late spring or early summer.
- One element of these pilot projects is to provide field EMS clinicians with real-time hospital status. This information will be displayed through pilot technology.
- EDs participating in these pilots will indicate ED and Specialty Care status in new ways, which may include mirroring Resource Bridge status within the pilot program.
- All EDs should be aware of the new diversion status option.
- **Only EDs participating in the ImageTrend Pilot should use this ED Diversion Status:**

SPECIALTY DIVERSION - CALL BASE (PILOT USE ONLY)

- This status is only used alongside existing specialty diversion options such as trauma, stroke, STEMI, or L&D; this new status allows ambulance crews to rapidly access information for these time-critical destination decisions.
- Base Hospitals will continue to provide online medical direction and destination assistance for ambulance patients requesting a facility with an applicable diversion status.
