RECEIVING FACILITY SIGNATURE & TRANSFER OF CARE TIME VALIDATION



The LEMSIS ePCR now includes an automated flag when the time between the **Receiving Facility Signature** and the **Destination Patient Transfer of Care Date/Time** exceeds 5 minutes. This alert is designed to improve accuracy in documenting the **Ambulance Patient Offload Time (APOT)**.

- » The Receiving Facility Signature (NEMSIS eOther.19) must be captured at the point when the patient is physically transferred to hospital staff, a verbal report is given, and the receiving provider signs the ePCR.
- » The Transfer of Care Date/Time (NEMSIS eTimes.12) should closely match this signature time, marking the official completion of patient offload.

Accurate, aligned timestamps support reliable APOT reporting and system-wide performance improvement.
