


CARE TIME VALIDATION



The LEMSIS ePCR now includes an automated flag when the time between the Receiving Facility Signature and the Destination Patient Transfer of Care Date/Time exceeds 5 minutes. This alert is designed to improve accuracy in documenting the Ambulance Patient Offload Time (APOT).

TO AVOID UNNECESSARY FLAGS & ENSURE COMPLIANT REPORTING



- ▶ The Receiving Facility Signature (NEMSIS eOther.19) must be captured at the point when the patient is physically transferred to hospital staff, a verbal report is given, and the receiving provider signs the ePCR.
- ▶ The Transfer of Care Date/Time (NEMSIS eTimes.12) should closely match this signature time, marking the official completion of patient offload.

Accurate, aligned timestamps support reliable APOT reporting and system-wide performance improvement.
