AUTHORITY: Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5, Section 1797.204.

I. PURPOSE

To identify standardized inventory for all Advanced Life Support (ALS) first responder units. Individual agencies may increase inventory to include all ALS medications, including controlled substances.

II. POLICY

Essential equipment and supplies to be carried on each ALS first responder unit shall include, at a minimum, the following:
