<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• O<sub>2</sub> and/or ventilate PRN</li> <li>• If antivenin available on site, transport with patient to hospital</li> </ul> <p><b>Jellyfish sting</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Liberally rinse with seawater</li> <li>• Scrape to remove stinger(s)</li> <li>• Heat as tolerated (not to exceed 110 °F / 43 °C)</li> </ul> <p><b>Stingray or sculpin injury</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Immersion in hot water (as hot as tolerated, not to exceed 110 °F / 43 °C)</li> </ul> <p><b>Snakebite</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mark proximal extent of swelling and/or tenderness</li> <li>• Keep involved extremity at heart level and immobile</li> <li>• Remove constrictive device(s)</li> <li>• Remove jewelry distal to bite</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IV SO</li> <li>• Treat per Pain Management Protocol (S-173)</li> </ul>
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
