LOCATION

The meeting will take place at the Center for Women's History at the San Diego History Center in Balboa Park, located at 1649 El Prado, Suite #3, San Diego, CA 92101. The meeting is open to the public.

PUBLIC PARKING

There are a variety of parking options at Balboa Park. Vehicles displaying a valid ADA placard can park for free in designated spaces within lots and on park roads.

Verified City of San Diego Residents may park in the Level 1 Lots (Space Theatre/Fleet Science Center, Casa de Balboa, Alcazar, Organ Pavillion, South Carousel) for \$5.00 for up to 4 hours or \$8.00 for the full day.

Level 2 and 3 Lots (Pepper Grove, Inspiration Point, Palisades, etc.) Free all day. You must register your vehicle's license plate on the City of San Diego Parking Portal Home to receive resident discounts.

For non City of San Diego residents, Level 1 Lots are \$10.00 for up to 4 hours or \$16.00 for the full day.

Level 2 Lots are \$10.00 flat rate for the full day.
